- **Biology:** Air, Water, Soil, Micro-organism, Reproduction, Life Processes, Heredity & Evolution, Food Production and Management, Diversity in Living Organism, Plant & Animal Nutrition & Human Body, Cellular Level of Organisation, Some Common Diseases & Our Environment.
